Pittsburgh Opera is pleased to offer Opera Opportunity as a way to include more students at opera performances. This program allows students and teachers from eligible middle and high schools to purchase reduced-price tickets. One or more teachers must attend the prerequisite Workshop for Educators.

Requirements for participation

- Complete application form, including the signature of the building principal.
- Submit requests for up to 30 tickets (total number of students and adult chaperones). Requests for number of tickets and preference for date of performance will be honored whenever possible, but are not guaranteed.
- Arrange for payment no later than one week prior to the performance.
- Attend the corresponding, prerequisite Workshop for Educators.
- Prepare the students before the opera to the fullest extent possible.
- Attend the opera and **supervise students**. Include one adult for every 8–15 students, 2 adults for 16–23 students, and 3 adults for 24–30 students.
